Under the direction of the Program Coordinator, provides care for children ages 5 to 12 for before and afterschool, professional development days and during the Winter, Spring and Summer breaks.

Performance Responsibilities

- Under the direction of the Program Coordinator, provides appropriate supervision of children both within the facility and outdoors.
