**Job Goal:**

Under the direction of the Program Coordinator, provides care for children ages 5 to 12 for before and afterschool, professional development days and during the Winter, Spring and Summer breaks.

**Performance Responsibilities**

1. Under the direction of the Program Coordinator, provides appropriate supervision of children both within the facility and outdoors.
2. Ensures the environment is healthy & safe for children.
3. Builds and maintains respectful relationships with children.
4. Assists children with reminders of cleanliness/hygiene.
5. Appropriately redirects and guides children's behavior.
6. Documents behavior and interactions of children when necessary, and reports concerns to the Program Coordinator.
7. In consultation with the Program Coordinator, plans and implements developmentally appropriate activities.
8. Establishes and maintains open lines of communications with staff & families.
9. Daily set up & take down of facility equipment.
10. Snack preparation and cleaning duties.

**Education and Experience Requirements**

- Grade 12, plus completion of 20 hours responsible adult training or completion of one of the following courses per the ECE Registry: Health, Safety and Nutrition, Child Growth and Development, or Guiding and Caring.
- 1-month related experience in a child care setting.
